Based in Dungannon (Northern Ireland). The company is specialised on the production of rigid packaging for the food industry in Great Britain and Ireland. With a keen focus on innovation Greiner Packaging Limited continually introduce new and bespoke package designs for production in new materials such as PET and decorated with the very latest sleeving and printing techniques.

In 2011 the Swiss artist Sabeth Holland was commissioned to create an adapted version of "Treasure Island I" for the company. She used the shape of the Greiner trade mark – called "The Pack" – as a base for her wall installation. She could also see an abstracted version of the Irish island in it and therefore found it to be appropriate to fill it with abstractions of fruity and floral treasures, as well as good wishes and dynamic symbols for a prosperous future. She worked with modern materials that were related to the company's own.
